General Instructions for all Scholarships

Submit to the Kenai River Campus, Financial Aid Office:

- Completed Application:** (Page 4) Answers left blank may exclude you from the selection process. Please include your complete mailing address.
- Financial Needs Assessment: Applicants are advised to fill out the 2009/2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to assist the Scholarship Committee in determining financial need.** Applicants who have not completed the FAFSA by the review date may not be considered for the KPC need-based scholarships. International students should stop by the Financial Aid Help Desk for further information or assistance with this part of the application.
- Attach a two page (double-spaced) personal essay outlining career and educational goals.**
- Attach unofficial transcripts:** All students, new and returning, must meet satisfactory academic progress according to University of Alaska standards. **Incoming freshman** – submit high school transcript or GED transcript. Unofficial UAA transcripts can be obtained via the UAOnline @ no expense. You must be making “Satisfactory Academic Progress” according to U of A policy.
- *Special Requirements* - Review scholarship descriptions (pages: 2 - 3)**
The following scholarships have additional requirements:
 - **Catherine Hays Memorial Scholarship** – Special Essay Requirement
 - **Arco/North Slope Borough Scholarship** – Proof of North Slope Borough residency (Villages of NSB: Barrow, Anaktuvuk Pass, Atqasuk, Kaktovik, Nuiqsut, Point Hope, Point Lay, Wainwright)
 - **Soldotna Lion’s Club Scholarship** -- The scholarship committee will be looking for an applicant who in action defines the Lion’s Club philosophy of volunteerism in a modern-day society.
 - **Joseph Kashi & Terese Kashi Science & Technology Scholarship** -- Open to students pursuing a bachelor’s degree or higher in specified science, technology or math. GPA & class standing restrictions apply.
- Admission Requirements: ALL** applicants must be officially admitted into either a KPC and/or UAA degree or certificate program. Some degree restrictions may apply, so be sure to review scholarship descriptions carefully.
- DEADLINE:** all applications must arrive at the **KPC - Kenai River Campus, Financial Aid Office by – 5:00 PM — Friday, November 6th, 2009**

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION LIST

- **Catherine Hays Memorial Scholarship: Open to Full-time, First-time freshman admitted in AA degree; GPA 2.5; attending Kenai River Campus.** The Hays Memorial Scholarship is created in memory of Mrs. Catherine A. Hays and her love of literature. Mrs. Hays was an avid reader of literature. Literature provides an understanding of social history, explores cultural values, and provides insight into the human experience.
Special Requirements: The personal essay must detail the applicant's beliefs and philosophy on the importance of "literature in modern day society." Applicants should pay careful attention to the quality of the essay. The selection committee will place primary emphasis on the content and the skill with which the applicant communicates his/her ideas in writing.

- **Joseph Kashi & Terese Kashi Science & Technology Scholarship --** Open to Full-time students, with a minimum 3.3 GPA, who are at the sophomore-level or higher, and pursuing a bachelor's degree or higher in biology, physics, chemistry, mathematics, or in civil, electrical, mechanical, geophysical, or structural engineering. Students must be **attending the Kenai River Campus (KRC.)** *In addition, full-time students currently attending the KRC may apply and transfer funds to another campus of the University of Alaska, if such applicant is transferring to complete their degree.*

- **Tuition Waiver :** Applicants may be **FULL-TIME** (minimum 12 credits) or **PART-TIME** (6-11 credits). Student must also be officially admitted in a UAA/KPC degree or certificate program. This scholarship is based on financial need. Tuition waivers will be awarded for **ONE** semester and cover tuition charges only. **** Fees must be paid by the student.** Cumulative grade point average must be 2.5 or better**, and student must be making satisfactory academic progress according to University of Alaska standards. *Scholarship is open to students from Kenai River Campus, Anchorage Extension Site, and Resurrection Bay Campus.*

- **Staff Scholarship: Part-time, GPA 2.5 or better**
This program is funded entirely by donations from the KPC, Kenai River Campus Classified and APT employees. Preference will be given to part-time (6-11 credit) students. **Minimum cumulative GPA requirement 2.5** *Scholarship is open to Kenai River Campus students only.*

- **Faculty Scholarship: Full-time, GPA 2.5 or better**
This program is funded entirely by donations from the KPC, Kenai River Campus faculty members. Preference will be given to full-time (12+ credits) students. **Minimum cumulative GPA requirement 2.5.** *Scholarship is open to Kenai River Campus students only.*

- **Student Union Scholarship: Part-time, GPA 2.0 or better**
This program is funded entirely by donations from the KPC, Kenai River Campus Student Union. Executive Board and representative members vote annually to determine support levels for this fund. Preference will be given to part-time students (6-11 credits), minimum Cum. GPA 2.0. *Scholarship is open to Kenai River Campus students only.*

- **Soldotna Lions Club: Open to full-time (12 cr. minimum)**
Applicants must currently have at least a **"B" (3.0)** cumulative grade point average and be attending the Kenai Peninsula College, *Kenai River Campus*. The scholarship committee will be looking for an applicant who in action defines the Lion's Club philosophy of **volunteerism in a modern-day society**. The recipient of this scholarship may be invited to attend a Lion's Club function where they will be honored with a certificate of award.

- **Arco/North Slope Borough Scholarship: Open to Full-time students, minimum GPA 2.0, recipients must be residents of the NSB. This scholarship was created to enable students from the NSB to attend KPC for two consecutive semesters. Recipients selected in the Fall term are eligible for a 12 credit tuition scholarship in the Fall, and an additional 12 credit tuition scholarship in the Spring term. First-time freshman may use their high school transcript or GED to satisfy the 2.0 requirement. Preference will be given to applicants seeking degrees in Process Technology or Industrial Process Instrumentation, or certificates in Welding or Mechanical Technology, but all applicants will be considered as long as they meet the minimum requirements and have submitted the required application materials.**
Special Requirements: Submit proof of North Slope Borough residency. Acceptable proof of residency includes, but is not limited to: driver's license with permanent address or voter registration card showing your name and address.
