NPRSA Women's Basketball League

Schedules:

The NPRSA Women's League begins in September and runs through October. League nights are Tuesdays and Fridays. Game schedules and times depend on the number of teams participating and will be provided to participants.

Uniforms:

Uniforms are required. Teams are responsible for providing their own uniforms. T-Shirts with numbers on the back are sufficient.

Games:

Please show up fifteen minutes before your game starts. It is recommended that you warm up and stretch before playing.

If a team is late, time will be taken off the clock. The game will be played.

If a team is short players, it is expected that the opposing team will provide players so that the game can continue. The game will be recorded as a forfeit for tournament standings, but will be played with officials and scorebooks.

All substitutes must check in with the scorekeeper before entering the game. You may only sub on a dead ball and with permission from the referees.

Rules:

Official High School Basketball rules apply with the following exceptions.

Games will be two, twenty-minute running halves with a 5 minute half-time. The clock will stop for all shooting fouls and on every whistle during the last two minutes of each half only. Two full time outs are permitted per half.

In the event of a tie, a three minute overtime will be played immediately. The clock will be stopped on every whistle during the last two minutes. One time out will be allowed. If a tie remains after the three minute overtime, teams will shoot free throws for the win. Each team will provide one shooter.

Sportsmanship:

Good sportsmanship is required. No foul language. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.

Any disrespect shown towards an official will result in that player being ejected from the game. Any player ejected from a game for disciplinary reasons will be suspended for the next scheduled game as well. Repeated offenses will result in that player being suspended from the league indefinitely by the League Director. A player receiving a technical foul must sit on the bench two minutes before the player can return to the game.

Officials have the option of stopping and forfeiting a game if it gets out of control.

Eligibility:

Only players who have signed and completed their paperwork and paid their player fee will be eligible to play. Additional players added after league start must be approved by the League Director. All players must be at least 18 years of age and out of high school to participate.
