New camera loaner program for photography students at KRC

Digital and film cameras will be available to students who are attending KPC's Kenai River Campus and exploring a career in photography and digital art. The cameras have been made possible by donations from the Soldotna Rotary Club and private donors.

The cameras will be checked out to students during Fall 2007 and Spring 2008 semesters as long as they are enrolled in a 3-credit digital or film photography course at KRC.

Cameras are awarded based on the candidate's interest in photography and digital art, financial need, and scholastic achievement, in that order. Priority will be given to full-time students or students enrolled in two or more art and photography courses. There will be two SLR digital cameras and two SLR film cameras available.
